General Application Form duly accomplished and notarized; 3. Certificate of Acceptance issued by learning institution/s duly accredited by the Bureau of Immigration to accept foreign students; and 4. Photocopy of applicant's passport showing its bio-page, admission and authorized stay.
Students are also required to bring the following documents: Passport, 4copies of '2x2' size pictures, Certificate of an exchange student, ₱ 5,240.00 /\$100 for Special Study Permit Fee
